In July 2015, a pilot was launched to kick start the expansion of clinical pharmacy in general practice. By December 2016, over 490 additional clinical pharmacists were working across approximately 650 GP practices across the country.

Following the success of the pilot, NHS England is inviting GP practices and other providers of general medical services to apply for funding to help recruit, train and develop more clinical pharmacists to meet the commitment of an additional 1,500 clinical pharmacists in general practice by 2020/21, as set out in the General Practice Forward View.

Provider organisations will be able to submit applications through an online portal available via www.england.nhs.uk from 9 January 2017.
