LMCSN UPDATES

New Local Enhanced Service Funding Library

We have worked with Cogora to develop a new Local Enhanced Service (LES) Funding Library, which is now available on the LMCSN website.

The library brings together information on more than 1,400 enhanced services across England, allowing you to explore and compare LES arrangements across different ICB areas.

You can search by service type, ICB or area, with information including:

- ICB budgets and funding allocations, where available
- Payments and remuneration offered to providers
- Summaries of individual enhanced services
- Full service specifications, where available

The information has been gathered through Freedom of Information requests to ICBs and provides LMCs with a useful reference point when reviewing local enhanced services or considering how similar services are commissioned elsewhere in England.

The library can be searched using terms such as anticoagulation, phlebotomy, ear irrigation or diabetes, making it easy to identify comparable services and funding arrangements.

Mike Harrison and BBOLMC have been busy enhancing the LMC DataBank, introducing new functionality to make accessing and visualising data even easier. The DataBank now consists of four views, allowing you to explore information in different ways.

How to access the DataBank:

- Access is for LMC Office/Secretariat team members for internal use only.
- Visit the LMC Support Network website: [LMC Support Network – Homepage](#)
- Enter your log-in details at the top right-hand side of the homepage.
- If you do not have a log-in, you can register here: LMC Support Network – [Join Us](#) (If eligible, you will be sent an email to create a password.)
- Click the LMC DataBank tab. You then have four options: Practice Level View, LMC Level View, Parliamentary View and Practice Boundary Map Tool.

Practice Level View – you can view the data for individual practices.

Search by: Region → LMC Consortium (if applicable) → LMC → PCN → Practice Name

LMC Level View – you can view the data for your LMC or LMC Consortium.

Search by: Region → LMC Consortium (if applicable) → LMC

Parliamentary View – you can view the data for your chosen Parliamentary constituency.

Search by: Parliamentary Region → Constituency

Practice Boundary Map – you can view your practice boundary maps.

Search by: Region → LMC Consortium (if applicable) → LMC → PCN → Practice Name

- Reset each time and reselect to view a different search.
